



Year 3 Summer Term Curriculum Map



ENGLISH

The children will apply skills they have previously learned to create an experience log based on the Wild Robot story. They will consolidate their understanding of punctuation and grammar rules. **Key Vocabulary:** experience log, conjunctions, adjectives, noun phrases, simile, adverb, adverbials, diary.

MATHS

The children will begin to learn about unit fractions and non-unit fractions.

Key Vocabulary: numerator, denominator, part, whole, fraction, divide.

SCIENCE

The children will learn about rocks. They will investigate hardness, permeability and other properties. **Key Vocabulary:** rock, metamorphic, sedimentary, igneous, im/permeable, fossil

HISTORY

Children will be learning about the Romans in Britain and why they invaded. There will be a particular focus on daily life in Roman Leicester. **Key Vocabulary:** invasion, Ratae Corieltavorum, baths, empire, Boudicca, testudo, hypocaust, mosaic, forum



PE

The children will be developing skills in athletics focussing on throwing and jumping for distance and running varied distances.

Key Vocabulary: pace, agility, stamina, technique, power

COMPUTING

The children will develop their understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one.

Key Vocabulary: branching database, information, structure, sort

MUSIC

The children will continue with weekly recorder lessons and develop their singing skills. They will compose a piece of music inspired by a sea voyage.

Key Vocabulary: note, tempo, rhythm, crotchets, rests, quavers, rounds, partner songs, graphic score, dynamics.

PSHE

In PSHE children will learn about personal safety, including safe secrets, relationships and safe touching as well as what to do if they ever feel unsafe. **Key Vocabulary:** Early warning signs, network of trust, permission, consent, physical.

FRENCH

The children will be learning fruits in French.

Key Vocabulary: les fruits, les pommes, les cerise, j'aime, je n'aime pas, les fraise, les fraise, les bananes.

RE

The children will explore how Jesus would want the world to be, and how this can impact the world around us today. **Key Vocabulary:** lepers, Samaritan, gospel, disciples, church leader: priest, vicar, deacon, minister, believers, non-believers

DT

The children will be learning about eating healthily, where foods come from and what is grown seasonally. They will be designing a healthy dish to consume. **Key Vocabulary:** vitamins, minerals, seasonal, imports, source.
